Parking Regulations

Parking regulations are enforced 24 hours a day, seven days a week, including holidays. Please obey all posted signs.

Remember

The following parking regulations are subject to citations and/or being towed: C.V.C. 21113(a)

- A. Red Zones
- B. Yellow or green curbs (20 minute limit)
- C. Visitors must park in designated spaces as directed by the Police Department.
- D. Vehicles must park in marked stalls.
- E. Valid permit not displayed.
- F. Handicapped parking
- G. Obstruction the normal flow of traffic

Students enrolled at Palomar College and carrying current semester units are considered students and are not eligible for a Guest Pass.
